Dear Shooting Friends,

On behalf of the European Shooting Confederation, the Italian Shooting Federation hereby invites you to the ESC Youth League Final. The competition will take place in Bologna (Italy). The Italian Shooting Federation will host the competition in the training Centre with 30 electronic targets from SIUS.

Venue – Shooting Range

The Venue is located in Via Agucchi, 98 Bologna; take note that is a fully active and well organized structure, that will be able to support all the necessities of the participating teams to the final round of the ESC Youth League Final.

Competition

The competition groups (G1, G2) and teams (T1, T2...) will be determined by drawing of lots at the technical meeting:

The competition consists of :

1. Qualification matches (4.2.1):
 - 5 min preparation time
 - 10 min sighters
 - 12 min for each 10 shots (total 40 shots)
2. Final matches (4.2.2):
 - 3 min preparation time
 - 5 min sighters
 - 20 shots, shot by shot 75s (as per ISSF rule), after each shot the results will be announced.

Youth shooters are shooters 14 – 18 years old (on the 31st of December 2010).

The mixed (male/female) team of each Federation consists of 3 shooters for air rifle and 3 shooters for air pistol (3 shooters from the 8 entered shooters maximum).

The ISSF ID Number is not necessary for the ESC Youth League.

The entry fee is **500 EUR for 3 to 8 shooters**. It will be paid on arrival.

Accommodation

The Organizing Committee has arranged accommodation for all participating team in Bologna in Hotel with the following price per room with breakfast included:

Reservation must be done directly to the Organising Committee not later than **01.09.10** on the enclosed hotel form.

Payment of 80% of total amount of hotel fee must be paid not later than 08.09.2010

Transportation

Please indicate by which means of transport you will arrive in Bologna. Pick up service will be made at Bologna Airport to the shooting range/hotel/airport. The cost is 30,00 EUR/ person.

Visa

Citizens of most European countries do not need entry visas for Italy.

Police permit

As soon as the Organizing Committee will receive the entry forms, Weapon Importation forms will be sent to the participating Federation. Take note that the importation forms must not be sent back to the Organizing Committee but presented to the border police.

The Italian Shooting Federation invites all participants to an “informal” banquet which will take place Saturday evening in a typical Italian Restaurant at 19:00.
